Dear MHS Junior/Senior Parents and Students:

It has come to our attention that a number of our junior and senior students are engaging in questionable activities while playing the game "Paranoia" in the community. Specifically, our school has now been contacted by both community parents and a local business that our students are choosing to remove all their clothing while playing the game. While this is **not a school-sponsored activity** for our students, we do worry about their safety while they are not at school.

The MHS Administration will work closely with our local law enforcement to make sure that our students are being respectful and safe, as well as not making any law violations stemming from these types of activities. Listed below are examples of municipal citations that could be issued for 1st offense violations, if any students are caught participating in the game:

- Criminal Damage to Property approximately \$564
- Criminal Trespass approximately \$439
- Curfew Violation approximately \$187
- Loitering/Prowling approximately \$439
- Disorderly Conduct approximately \$439

If you have any concerns about behaviors or damage to property, please contact the Mukwonago Police Department.

If students are caught playing the game on school property, they will face consequences which may include an out-of-school suspension, an Athletic Code Violation, and loss of the ability to attend Prom.

Parents, please speak to your student to see if they are involved in this activity and please convey the safety concerns we have. We appreciate partnering with you to make sure that our students are safe acting appropriately in our community in and out of school.
